$$\frac{([\text{No. of GP3 Credits}] \times 3) + ([\text{No. of GP2 Credits}] \times 2) + ([\text{No. of GP1 Credits}] \times 1) + ([\text{No. of GP0 Credits}] \times 0)}{\text{Total Number of Registered Credits}}$$

Example for type6

Total credits earned in the previous academic year: 33

A: 15 credits, B: 9 credits, C: 3 credits, D: 3 credits, F: 3 credits

$$\{(15 \times 3) + (9 \times 3) + (3 \times 2) + (3 \times 1)\} / (15 + 9 + 3 + 3 + 3) = 2.45$$
